Notification of O-SIIs in Denmark

Finanstilsynet (The Danish FSA) has on June 19 2014 identified six O-SIIs in Denmark in accordance with Article 308 of the Danish Financial Business Act implementing Article 131 of Directive 2013/36/EU.

In accordance with Article 131, paragraph 12, Finanstilsynet is required to notify the names of the other systemic institutions (O-SIIs) and the respective subcategories to the Commission.

The following O-SIIs have been identified in Denmark: Danske Bank A/S, Nykredit Realkredit A/S, Nordea Bank Danmark A/S, Jyske Bank A/S, Sydbank A/S and DLR Kredit A/S. The identification is made on a consolidated or sub consolidated basis and on an individual basis where the institution is not part of a group.

The identification is based on the following criteria, where only one needs to be met in order to be identified:

- Total assets in per cent of GDP > 6.5 per cent
- Loans in per cent of the total lending by the sector > 5 per cent
- Deposits in per cent of the total deposits of the sector > 5 per cent

Danish O-SIIs are allocated into five different subcategories based on the level of systemic importance of the institutions. The systemic importance is calculated as an average of the total assets in per cent of the total assets of the sector, loans in per cent of the total lending by the sector and deposits in per cent of the total deposits of the sector. The allocation is shown below:

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MINISTRY OF BUSINESS AND GROWTH

The Minister for Business and Growth is expected to set a systemic risk buffer, to be met by the identified O-SIIs, with a transitional period from 1 January 2015 to 1 January 2019.
